Growing Notes

Bedrock Vineyard is one of the most historically and qualitatively gilded plots of land in Sonoma Valley. Taking up 152 acres of the heart of Sonoma Valley, the vineyard occupies a large section of one of the best-growing climates for grapes on earth. Founded in 1854, Bedrock Vineyard has grown grapes for over 150 years and is currently owned and farmed by the Peterson Family (Bedrock Wine Co.). It is a privilege to work with such a rich piece of California history. Bedrock's understanding of farming and preserving old vines has provided a blueprint for more recent restorations around the state.

We began the 2022 season with bud break starting in February and the rest of the growing season continuing to track on the early side. We started harvesting in late August and were completely finished picking by September 13th. Lighter-than-average yields also contributed to incredibly nuanced and intense flavor characteristics. Meticulous farming and careful winemaking techniques came together to make this vintage a stand-out year with each cluster reaching a beautiful level of ripeness and balance.

Tasting Notes

Muddled blackberry, cacao, and anise aromas collide making for an elegant and inviting Cabernet Sauvignon. The palate is gifted with notes of fig, black cherry, and undertones of fresh thyme followed by structured tannins. Notes of baking spices are subtle on the finish and tannins have a beautiful lingering effect.
